 2 An act relating to the Reduced Cigarette Ignition
 3 Propensity Standard and Firefighter Protection Act
 4 Enforcement Fund; amending s. 633.042, F.S.; creating the
 5 Reduced Cigarette Ignition Propensity Standard and
 6 Firefighter Protection Act Enforcement Fund; providing for
 7 source of moneys and purposes; providing for annual
 8 carryforward of unused funds; providing for future review
 9 and termination or re-creation of the fund; providing a
 10 contingent effective date.

 12 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

 14 Section 1. Paragraph (f) of subsection (5) of section
 15 633.042, Florida Statutes, is redesignated as paragraph (g), and
 16 a new paragraph (f) is added to that subsection to read:

17 633.042 Reduced Cigarette Ignition Propensity Standard and
 18 Firefighter Protection Act.—

19 (5) CERTIFICATION AND PRODUCT CHANGE.--

20 (f)1. There is created in the State Treasury a separate,
 21 nonlapsing fund to be known as the "Reduced Cigarette Ignition
 22 Propensity Standard and Firefighter Protection Act Enforcement
 23 Fund." The fund shall consist of all certification fees
 24 submitted by manufacturers and shall, in addition to any other
 25 funds made available for such purpose, be available to the
 26 division solely to support processing, testing, enforcement, and
 27 oversight activities required by this section.

28 2. Notwithstanding the provisions of s. 216.301 and
29 pursuant to s. 216.351, any balance in the fund at the end of
30 any fiscal year shall remain in the fund at the end of the year
31 and shall be available for carrying out the purposes of the
32 fund.

33 3. In accordance with s. 19(f)(2), Art. III of the State
34 Constitution the fund shall be terminated on January 1, 2014,
35 unless terminated sooner. Before its scheduled termination, the
36 fund shall be reviewed as provided in s. 215.3206(1) and (2).

37 Section 2. This act shall take effect January 1, 2010, if
38 House Bill 1167 or substantially similar legislation is adopted
39 in the same legislative session or an extension thereof and
40 becomes law.
