HB 1199 2008

A bill to be entitled

An act relating to trust funds; creating the Lead Poisoning Prevention Trust Fund within the Department of Health; providing for a source of funds and purposes of the trust fund; providing for an annual carryforward of funds; providing for future review and termination or recreation of the trust fund; providing a contingent effective date.

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Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

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- (1) The Lead Poisoning Prevention Trust Fund is created within the Department of Health. Funds credited to the trust fund shall consist of fees generated from examinations and certification required under the Florida Lead-based Paint Reduction Program pursuant to s. 381.99, Florida Statutes.
- Notwithstanding s. 216.301, Florida Statutes, and (2) pursuant to s. 216.351, Florida Statutes, any balance in the trust fund at the end of any fiscal year shall remain in the fund and be available for carrying out the purposes of the trust fund.
- In accordance with s. 19(f)(2), Art. III of the State Constitution, the trust fund shall, unless terminated sooner, be terminated on July 1, 2012. Before its scheduled termination, the trust fund shall be reviewed as provided in s. 215.3206(1) and (2), Florida Statutes.
- This act shall take effect July 1, 2008, if HB Section 2. 1197 or similar legislation is adopted in the same legislative

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29 session or an extension thereof and becomes law.

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
