8 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Paragraph (d) of subsection (1) of section212.096, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

12 212.096 Sales, rental, storage, use tax; enterprise zone

14 (1) For the purposes of the credit provided in this15 section:

16 (d) "Job" means a full-time position, as consistent with terms used by the Agency for Workforce Innovation and the United 17 States Department of Labor for purposes of unemployment 18 19 compensation tax administration and employment estimation resulting directly from a business operation in this state. This 20 21 term may not include a temporary construction job involved with 22 the construction of facilities or any job that has previously been included in any application for tax credits under s. 23 220.181(1). The term also includes employment of an employee 24 leased from an employee leasing company licensed under chapter 25 26 468 if such employee has been continuously leased to the employer for an average of at least 36 hours per week for more 27 than 6 months.
