 13 crime, and suffered a psychiatric or psychological injury

15           (c) A person against whom a forcible felony was committed  
 16 and who suffers a psychiatric or psychological injury as a  
 17 direct result of that crime but who does not otherwise sustain a  
 18 personal physical injury or death.
