Section 5. Subsection (5) of section 372.9901, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

8 372.9901 Seizure of illegal hunting devices; disposition; 9 notice; forfeiture.--In order to protect the state's wildlife resources, any vehicle, vessel, animal, gun, light, or other 10 hunting device used or attempted to be used in connection with, 11 12 as an instrumentality of, or in aiding and abetting in the commission of an offense prohibited by s. 372.99 is subject to 13 seizure and forfeiture. The provisions of chapter 932 do not 14 15 apply to any seizure or forfeiture under this section. For purposes of this section, a conviction is any disposition other 16 than acquittal or dismissal. 17
