15	(4) A reporting individual or procurement employee or any
16	other person on his or her behalf is prohibited from knowingly

18	committee or committee of continuous existence, as defined in s.
19	106.011, or from a lobbyist who lobbies the reporting
20	individual's or procurement employee's agency, or directly or
21	indirectly on behalf of the partner, firm, employer, or principal
22	of a lobbyist, if he or she knows or reasonably believes that the
23	gift has a value in excess of \$100; however, such a gift may be
24	accepted by such person on behalf of a governmental entity or a
25	charitable organization. If the gift is accepted on behalf of a
26	governmental entity or charitable organization, the person
27	receiving the gift shall not maintain custody of the gift for any
28	period of time beyond that reasonably necessary to arrange for
29	the transfer of custody and ownership of the gift.
