9 comply with the department's requirements for issuing temporary
10 tags license plates using the electronic system, the department
11 may deny, suspend, or revoke a license under s. 320.27(9)(b)16.
12 upon proof that the licensee has failed to comply with the
13 department's requirements. The department may adopt rules to
14 administer this section.

17 and issue system required for use by every department-authorized
18 issuer of temporary tags by the end of the 2007-2008 fiscal
19 year. Such system shall enable the department to issue, on
20 demand, a temporary tag number in response to a request from the
21 issuer by way of a secure electronic exchange of data and enable
22 the issuer to print the temporary tag that has all required
23 information. A motor vehicle dealer licensed under this chapter
24 may charge a fee to comply with this subsection.

25 (b) To ensure the continuation of operations for issuers
26 if a system outage occurs, the department shall allow the
27 limited use of a backup manual issuance method during an outage
28 which requires recordkeeping of information as determined by the
29 department and requires the timely electronic reporting of this
30 information to the department.

31 (c) The department may adopt rules necessary to administer
32 this subsection. Such rules may include exemptions from the
33 requirements of this subsection as required to administer the
34 program, as well as exemptions for issuers who do not require a
35 dealer license under this chapter because of the type or size of
36 vehicle being sold.
