Section 2. Subsection (3) of section 400.464, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

400.464 Home Health agencies to be licensed; expiration of license; exemptions; unlawful acts; penalties.--

(3) A ~~Any~~ home infusion therapy provider must ~~shall~~ be licensed as a home health agency or nurse registry. ~~Any infusion therapy provider currently authorized to receive Medicare reimbursement under a DME - Part B Provider number for the provision of infusion therapy shall be licensed as a non certified home health agency. Such a provider shall continue to~~
