

The levels of service 19 required in the transportation methodology shall be the same 20 21 levels of service used to evaluate concurrency in accordance with s. 163.3180. The regional planning agency shall provide the 22 23 developer information about the development-of-regional-impact 24 process and the use of preapplication conferences to identify 25 issues, coordinate appropriate state and local agency 26 requirements, and otherwise promote a proper and efficient review 27 of the proposed development. If agreement is reached regarding assumptions and methodology to be used in the application for 28 29 development approval, the reviewing agencies may not subsequently object to those assumptions and methodologies unless subsequent 30 31 changes to the project or information obtained during the review 32 make those assumptions and methodologies inappropriate. 33 34 And the title is amended as follows: 35 On line 3048, after the semicolon, 36 37 insert: requiring a specified level of service for certain 38 transportation methodologies; 39
