Delete line(s) 296-341 and insert:

2.a. If the victim was under the age of 18, a prohibition on living within 1,000 feet of a school, child care facility day care center, park as defined in s. 794.0701, playground, designated public school bus stop, or other place where children regularly congregate. A releasee who is subject to this subparagraph may not relocate to a residence that is within 1,000 feet of a public school bus stop.

b. Beginning October 1, 2004, the commission or the department may not approve a residence that is located within 1,000 feet of a school, child care facility day care center, park as defined in s. 794.0701, playground, designated school bus

stop, or other place where children regularly congregate for any releasee who is subject to this subparagraph. On October 1, 2004, the department shall notify each affected school district of the location of the residence of a releasee 30 days prior to release and thereafter, if the releasee relocates to a new residence, shall notify any affected school district of the residence of the releasee within 30 days after relocation. If, on October 1, 2004, any public school bus stop is located within 1,000 feet of the existing residence of such releasee, the district school board shall relocate that school bus stop. Beginning October 1, 2004, a district school board may not establish or relocate a public school bus stop within 1,000 feet of the residence of a releasee who is subject to this subparagraph. The failure of the district school board to comply with this subparagraph shall not result in a violation of conditional release supervision.

c. If the victim was under the age of 18, beginning October 1, 2008, neither the commission nor the department may approve a residence located within 1,000 feet of any designated school bus stop or within 1,500 feet of a school, child care facility, park as defined in s. 794.0701, playground, or other place where children regularly congregate for any releasee who is subject to this subparagraph. The distance in this sub-subparagraph shall be measured in a straight line from the offender's place of residence to the nearest boundary line of any designated school bus stop, school, child care facility, park as defined in s. 794.0701, playground, or other place where children regularly congregate. The distance may not be measured by a pedestrian route or automobile route.
