For the purpose of incorporating the amendment 34 made by this act to section 285.16, Florida Statutes, in a 35 reference thereto, subsection (3) of section 285.061, Florida 36 Statutes, is reenacted to read: 37 285.061 Transfer of land to United States in trust for 38 Seminole and Miccosukee Indian Tribes.--39 (3) All the provisions of this chapter, not in conflict 40 with this section, remain in full force and effect. The state 41 reserves both civil and criminal jurisdiction over said 42 reservations in accordance with ss. 285.16 and 285.165 and 43 applicable federal law. All law enforcement personnel employed shall be 61 considered peace officers for all purposes and shall have the authority to bear arms, make arrests, and apply for, serve, and 62 63 execute search warrants, arrest warrants, capias, and other 64 process of the court, and to enforce criminal and noncriminal traffic offenses, within their respective special improvement 65 66 districts.

- 67 2. All law enforcement personnel shall be entitled to the68 privileges, protection, and benefits of ss. 112.19 and 870.05.
