HB 1501 2008

A bill to be entitled

An act relating to a personal financial responsibility pilot program; establishing a 3-year pilot program in the state for certain purposes; providing a program goal; requiring the Commissioner of Education to develop a program curriculum and select certain school districts for participation; requiring a report to the Governor and Legislature; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. A 3-year pilot program is established to provide high school students in two school districts in each of the northern, middle, and southern regions of the state with personal financial responsibility instruction. The goal of the pilot program will be to ensure that high school students in pilot program districts receive instruction on budgeting, saving and investing, credit card debt, and other issues associated with personal financial responsibility. The Commissioner of Education shall develop a curriculum for the program and select the school districts for participation in the program. At the conclusion of the pilot program, the Commissioner of Education shall report to the Governor, the President of the Senate, and the Speaker of the House of Representatives on the feasibility of implementing the program on a statewide basis.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2008.
