A bill to be entitled An act relating to the Sebring Airport Authority, Highlands County; amending section 8 of the charter of the Sebring Airport Authority; providing exceptions to requirements for sealed bids for contracts for professional services; providing requirements for procuring professional services; authorizing the authority to enter into continuing contracts; providing authority for selecting professional services providers under continuing contracts; providing an effective date. 45 46 Consultant's Competitive Negotiation Act applies, or supplies involving an expenditure of more than \$10,000, shall be awarded by the authority unless the authority advertises for sealed bids at least once a week for 2 consecutive weeks and such contract is awarded to the lowest responsible bidder. However, the authority may reject all bids. Professional services shall be procured as provided in the Consultant's Competitive Negotiation Act, and the authority is authorized to enter into continuing contracts with multiple qualified professional service providers. If continuing contracts are executed between the authority and multiple qualified professional service providers, the authority is authorized to select one of the qualified professional services providers to prepare a scope of work, or design criteria package, as may be appropriate, and then request the remaining qualified professional service providers to submit bids on that project. The authority may utilize any other selection process or criteria authorized by law. Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
