Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

6 Between line(s) 2157 and 2158,
7 insert:

8 Section 41. Recycling.--

9 (1) The Legislature finds that the failure or inability to
 10 economically recover material and energy resources from solid
 11 waste results in the unnecessary waste and depletion of our
 12 natural resources. Therefore, the maximum recycling and reuse of
 13 such resources must be a high-priority goal of this state.

14 (2) The long-term goal for reducing solid waste through the
 15 recycling efforts of state and local governmental entities shall,
 16 by the year 2020, be a statewide average reduction of 75 percent

17 of the amount of solid waste that was disposed of in 2007, not
18 including any recycling efforts undertaken during that year.

19 (3) The Department of Environmental Protection shall, by
20 January 1, 2010, develop a recycling program in conjunction with
21 state and local governments which is designed to meet the
22 reduction goal stated in subsection (2).
