- (a) Include requirements in the 2010 edition of the Florida Building Code to increase the energy-efficiency performance of new buildings by at least 20 percent as compared to the performance achieved as a result of the implementation of the energy-efficiency provisions contained in the 2004 edition of the Florida Building Code, as amended on May 22, 2007;
- (b) Include requirements in the 2013 edition of the Florida Building Code to increase the energy-efficiency performance of new buildings by at least 30 percent as compared to the performance achieved as a result of the implementation of the

- (d) Include requirements in the 2019 edition of the Florida Building Code to increase the energy-efficiency performance of new buildings by at least 50 percent as compared to the performance achieved as a result of the implementation of the energy-efficiency provisions contained in the 2004 edition of the Florida Building Code, as amended on May 22, 2007.
