Section 1. Section 943.082, Florida Statutes, is created
to read:
943.082 Police Technology Trust Fund
(1) The Police Technology Trust Fund is created within the
department. Funds credited to the trust fund shall consist of
revenues collected from the fee imposed under s. 938.135. The
trust fund shall be administered by the department and used to
allocate funds to public county or municipal law enforcement
agencies to purchase and maintain technology equipment to be
used in their law enforcement activities. Equipment that may be
purchased and maintained with grants under this section may
include, but is not limited to, in-car cameras and personal
digital recorders to record encounters with suspects. The fee
collected for each offense shall be distributed only to the law
enforcement agency responsible for the arrest for that offense.
