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8	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:
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10	Section 1. Section 627.42395, Florida Statutes, is amended
11	to read:
12	627.42395 Coverage for certain prescription and
13	nonprescription enteral <u>or amino acid</u> formulas
14	(1) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, any health
15	insurance policy delivered or issued for delivery, to any person
16	in this state or any group, blanket, or franchise health
17	insurance policy delivered or issued for delivery in this state
18	shall make available to the policyholder as part of the
19	application, for an appropriate additional premium, coverage for <u>:</u>
20	(a) Prescription and nonprescription enteral formulas for
21	home use which are physician prescribed as medically necessary
22	for the treatment of inherited diseases of amino acid, organic
23	acid, carbohydrate, or fat metabolism as well as malabsorption
24	originating from congenital defects present at birth or acquired
25	during the neonatal period. <u>Such</u> coverage for inherited diseases
26	of amino acids and organic acids shall include food products
27	modified to be low protein, in an amount not to exceed \$2,500
28	annually for any insured individual, through the age of 24.
29	(b) Amino-acid-based elemental formulas, regardless of the

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30	method of intake, for the medically necessary treatment of
31	medically diagnosed conditions such as severe multiple food
32	protein allergies, gastroesophageal reflux, eosinophilic
33	disorders, and short bowel syndrome when ordered by a licensed
34	physician.
35	(2) This section applies to any person or family
36	notwithstanding the existence of any preexisting condition.
37	Section 2. This act shall take effect October 1, 2008.
