7 Section 3. Lt. Colonel Robert T. Heagy, Jr., Memorial
8 Highway designated; Department of Transportation to erect
9 suitable markers.--

10 (1) The portion of U.S. Highway 441 between County Road 318
11 and NW 193rd Street in Marion County is designated as the "Lt.
12 Colonel Robert T. Heagy, Jr., Memorial Highway."

13 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to erect
14 suitable markers designating the Lt. Colonel Robert T. Heagy,
15 Jr., Memorial Highway, as described in subsection (1).

16 Section 4. Cutler Bay Boulevard designated; Department of
17 Transportation to erect suitable markers.--

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18 (1) The portion of U.S. 1 in Miami-Dade County from S.W.
19 184th Street to S.W. 112th Avenue, inclusive, is designated as
20 "Cutler Bay Boulevard."

21 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to erect
22 suitable markers designating Cutler Bay Boulevard as described in
23 subsection (1).

24 Section 5. Palmetto Bay Boulevard designated; Department of
25 Transportation to erect suitable markers.--

26 (1) The portion of U.S. 1 in Miami-Dade County from S.W.
27 136th Street to S.W. 184th Street, inclusive, is designated as
28 "Palmetto Bay Boulevard."

29 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to erect
30 suitable markers designating Palmetto Bay Boulevard as described
31 in subsection (1).

32 Section 6. American Legion Way designated; Department of
33 Transportation to erect suitable markers.--

34 (1) The portion of S.W. 59th Avenue in Miami-Dade County
35 from S.W. 80th Street to S.W. 72nd Street is designated as
36 "American Legion Way."

37 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to erect
38 suitable markers designating American Legion Way as described in
39 subsection (1).

40 Section 7. Honorable Robert B. Ingram, Ph.D., Boulevard
41 designated; Department of Transportation to erect suitable
42 markers.--

43 (1) The portion of Opa-Locka Boulevard/N.W. 135th Street in
44 Miami-Dade County between N.W. 7th Avenue and N.W. 47th Avenue is
45 designated as "Honorable Robert B. Ingram, Ph.D., Boulevard."



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46 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to erect
47 suitable markers designating Honorable Robert B. Ingram, Ph.D.,
48 Boulevard as described in subsection (1).

49 Section 8. Father Emilio Vallina Avenue designated;
50 Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers.--

51 (1) The portion of West Flagler Street in Miami-Dade County
52 between 13th Avenue and 14th Avenue is designated as "Father
53 Emilio Vallina Avenue."

54 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to erect
55 suitable markers designating Father Emilio Vallina Avenue as
56 described in subsection (1).

57 Section 9. United States Army Specialist Brandon Tyler
58 Thorsen Memorial Highway designated; Department of Transportation
59 to erect suitable markers.--

60 (1) The portion of U.S. Highway 19/98 (State Road 55) and
61 U.S. Alternate 27 (State Road 500) in Levy County in front of the
62 Chiefland High School is designated as "United States Army
63 Specialist Brandon Tyler Thorsen Memorial Highway."

64 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to erect
65 suitable markers designating United States Army Specialist
66 Brandon Tyler Thorsen Memorial Highway as described in subsection
67 (1).

68 Section 10. John E. Andrews Boulevard designated; Department
69 of Transportation to erect suitable markers.--

70 (1) The portion of Edgewood Avenue in Duval County between
71 Beaver Street and Roosevelt Boulevard is designated as "John E.
72 Andrews Boulevard."

73 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to erect
74 suitable markers designating John E. Andrews Boulevard as
75 described in subsection (1).



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76 Section 11. George Matthews Boulevard designated;
77 Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers.--

78 (1) The portion of Wilson Boulevard in Duval County between
79 I-295 South and Old Middleburg Road is designated as "George
80 Matthews Boulevard."

81 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to erect
82 suitable markers designating George Matthews Boulevard as
83 described in subsection (1).

84 Section 12. Angela Webb Hammonds Boulevard designated;
85 Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers.--

86 (1) The portion of New Kings Road in Duval County between
87 Davis Street and Myrtle Avenue is designated as "Angela Webb
88 Hammonds Boulevard."

89 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to erect
90 suitable markers designating Angela Webb Hammonds Boulevard as
91 described in subsection (1).

92 Section 13. Willie F. Faust Boulevard designated;
93 Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers.--

94 (1) The portion of Martin Luther King, Jr., Boulevard in
95 Duval County between Myrtle Avenue and Moncrief Road is
96 designated as "Willie F. Faust Boulevard."

97 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to erect
98 suitable markers designating Willie F. Faust Boulevard as
99 described in subsection (1).

100 Section 14. James H. Argrett, Sr., Avenue designated;
101 Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers.--

102 (1) The portion of Edgewood Avenue West in Duval County
103 between Avenue B and Moncrief Road is designated as "James H.
104 Argrett, Sr., Avenue."

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105 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to erect
106 suitable markers designating James H. Argrett, Sr., Avenue as
107 described in subsection (1).

108 Section 15. Veteran's Memorial Parkway designated;
109 Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers.--

110 (1) The portion of State Road 72 in Sarasota County from a
111 point immediately east of I-75 to the entrance of the National
112 Veterans Cemetery in Sarasota is designated as "Veteran's
113 Memorial Parkway."

114 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to erect
115 suitable markers designating Veteran's Memorial Parkway as
116 described in subsection (1).

117 Section 16. Gil Waters Bridge designated; Department of
118 Transportation to erect suitable markers.--

119 (1) The portion of SR 890/GulfStream Avenue in Sarasota
120 between Sunset Drive and Bird Key Drive is designated as "Gil
121 Waters Bridge."

122 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to erect
123 suitable markers designating Gil Waters Bridge as described in
124 subsection (1).

125 Section 17. Joseph P. Bertrand Building designated;
126 Department of Management Services to erect suitable markers.--

127 (1) The Regional Transportation Management Center in Fort
128 Myers is designated the "Joseph P. Bertrand Building".

129 (2) The Department of Management Services may erect
130 suitable markers designating the "Joseph P. Bertrand Building" as
131 described in subsection (1).

132 Section 18. Section 589.19, Florida Statutes, is amended to
133 read:



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134 589.19 Creation of certain state forests; naming of certain
135 state forests.--

136 (1) When the Board of Trustees of the Internal Improvement
137 Trust Fund, any state agency, or any agency created by state law,
138 authorized to accept reforestation lands in the name of the
139 state, approve the recommendations of the Division of Forestry in
140 reference to the acquisition of land and acquire such land, the
141 said board, state agency, or agency created by state law, may
142 formally designate and dedicate any area as a reforestation
143 project, or state forest, and where so designated and dedicated
144 such area shall be under the administration of the division which
145 shall be authorized to manage and administer said area according
146 to the purpose for which it was designated and dedicated.

147 (2) The first state forest acquired by the Board of
148 Trustees of the Internal Improvement Trust Fund in Baker County
149 is to be named the John M. Bethea State Forest. This is to honor
150 Mr. John M. Bethea who was Florida's fourth state forester and
151 whose distinguished career in state government spanned 46 years
152 and who is a native of Baker County.

153 (3) The state forest managed by the Division of Forestry in
154 Seminole County is to be named the Charles H. Bronson State
155 Forest to honor Charles H. Bronson, the tenth Commissioner of
156 Agriculture, for his distinguished contribution to this state's
157 agriculture and natural resources.
