17 and issue system required for use by every department-authorized
18 issuer of temporary tags by the end of the 2007-2008 fiscal
19 year. This system shall enable the department to issue, on
20 demand, a temporary tag number in response to a request from the
21 issuer by way of a secure electronic exchange of data and then
22 enable the issuer to print the temporary tag with all required
23 information. A motor vehicle dealer licensed under ch. 320 shall
24 be authorized to charge a fee to comply with this subsection.

25 (b) To ensure the continuation of operations for issuers if
26 a system outage occurs, the department shall allow limited use
27 of a backup manual issuance method during an outage which
28 requires the record keeping of information as determined by the
29 department and which requires the timely electronic reporting of
30 this information to the department.

31 (c) The department may adopt rules as necessary to
32 implement this subsection. Such rules may include exemptions
33 from the requirements of this subsection as feasibly required to
34 implement the program, as well as for issuers who do not require
35 a dealer license under this chapter because of the type or size
36 of vehicle being sold.
