11	(2) For the purposes of this section, the term "small
12	county" means any county that has a population of 75,000 or less
13	according to <u>the most recently available decennial</u> 1990 federal
14	census data.
15	(3) Beginning with fiscal year 1999-2000 until fiscal year
16	2009-2010 up to \$25 million annually from the State
17	Transportation Trust Fund may be used for the purposes of funding
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18 the Small County Road Assistance Program as described in this 19 section.

In determining a county's eligibility for assistance 21 (b) 22 under this program, the department may consider whether the 23 county has attempted to keep county roads in satisfactory 24 condition, including the amount of local option fuel tax and ad valorem millage rate imposed by the county. The department may 25 26 also consider the extent to which the county has offered to 27 provide a match of local funds with state funds provided under the program. At a minimum, small counties shall be eligible only 28 29 if÷

30 1. the county has enacted the maximum rate of the local 31 option fuel tax authorized by s. 336.025(1)(a), and has imposed 32 an ad valorem millage rate of at least 8 mills; or

33 2. The county has imposed an ad valorem millage rate of 10 34 mills.

35 Section 4. Paragraph (c) of subsection (4) of section
36 348.0003, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

348.0003 Expressway authority; formation; membership.-(4)

(c) Notwithstanding any other provision of the Florida 39 40 Expressway Authority Act, members of each expressway an authority 41 shall be required to comply with the applicable financial 42 disclosure requirements of s. 8, Art. II of the State Constitution. This paragraph does not subject a statutorily 43 created expressway authority, other than the one created under 44 45 this part, to any of the requirements of this part other than 46 those contained in this subsection.
