30 (12)Beginning in the 2008-2009 fiscal year 2007-2008, the 31 sum of \$5 million \$13.5 million is appropriated annually from 32 recurring funds in the General Revenue Fund to the Grants and 33 Donations Trust Fund within the Department of Elderly Affairs for 34 the Johnnie B. Byrd, Sr., Alzheimer's Center and Research Institute at the University of South Florida for the purposes as 35 36 provided under paragraph (6) (a), conducting and supporting research, providing institutional research grants and 37 38 investigator-initiated research grants, developing and operating 39 integrated data projects, and providing assistance to statutorily 40 designated memory disorder clinics as provided under s. 430.502. 41 Not less than 80 percent of the appropriated funds shall be 42 expended for these purposes, and not less than 20 percent of the 43 appropriated funds shall be expended for peer-reviewed 44 investigator-initiated research grants.
