19	where W = the overall gross weight on any group of two or more
20	consecutive axles to the nearest 500 pounds; $L =$ the distance in
21	feet between the extremes of any group of two or more consecutive
22	axles; and N = the number of axles in the group under
23	consideration. Such overall gross weight of any vehicle or
24	combination of vehicles may not exceed 80,000 pounds, including
25	all enforcement tolerances, except that, for a vehicle or
26	combination of vehicles moving agricultural or forestry products
27	from the point of harvest to the first point of marketing or
28	processing when no part of such movement is upon any highway
29	designated as a part of the National System of Interstate and
30	Defense Highways, the vehicle or combination of vehicles may not
31	exceed an overall gross weight of 84,000 pounds, including all
32	enforcement tolerances.
