Section 1. Paragraph (d) of subsection (1) of section 202.12, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

202.12 Sales of communications services. -- The Legislature finds that every person who engages in the business of selling communications services at retail in this state is exercising a taxable privilege. It is the intent of the Legislature that the tax imposed by chapter 203 be administered as provided in this chapter.

(1) For the exercise of such privilege, a tax is levied on each taxable transaction, and the tax is due and payable as follows:



(d) At the rate set forth in paragraph (a) applied to the sales price of all mobile communications services deemed to be provided to a customer by a home service provider pursuant to s. 117(a) of the Mobile Telecommunications Sourcing Act, Pub. L. No. 106-252, if such customer's service address is located within this state. Effective January 1, 2009, the rate shall be reduced by the percentage necessary to reduce the total estimated collections in 2009 under this paragraph by the amount of any estimated increase in state sales and use tax collections during 2009 resulting from the repeal of sales tax exemptions provided under chapter 212 during the 2008 legislative session, unless otherwise provided by law. The estimated amounts shall be determined by reference to the 2008 Florida Tax Handbook.
