15	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

17	Section 1. Paragraph (b) of subsection (2) of section
18	210.20, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:
19	210.20 Employees and assistants; distribution of funds
20	(2) As collections are received by the division from such
21	cigarette taxes, it shall pay the same into a trust fund in the
22	State Treasury designated "Cigarette Tax Collection Trust Fund"
23	which shall be paid and distributed as follows:
24	(b)1. Beginning January 1, 2008 1999 , and continuing
25	through June 30, 2038 for 10 years thereafter, the division shall
26	from month to month certify to the Chief Financial Officer the
27	amount derived from the cigarette tax imposed by s. 210.02, less
28	the service charges provided for in s. 215.20 and less 0.9
29	percent of the amount derived from the cigarette tax imposed by

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s. 210.02, which shall be deposited into the Alcoholic Beverage 30 31 and Tobacco Trust Fund, specifying an amount equal to 2.59 32 percent of the net collections, and that amount shall be paid to the Board of Directors of the H. Lee Moffitt Cancer Center and 33 Research Institute, established under s. 1004.43, by warrant 34 drawn by the Chief Financial Officer upon the State Treasury. 35 These funds are hereby appropriated monthly out of the Cigarette 36 37 Tax Collection Trust Fund, to be used for the purpose of 38 constructing, furnishing, and equipping a cancer research, 39 treatment, and related facilities. facility at the University of 40 South Florida adjacent to the H. Lee Moffitt Cancer Center and 41 Research Institute. In fiscal years 1999-2000 and thereafter with the exception of fiscal year 2008-2009, The appropriation to the 42 43 H. Lee Moffitt Cancer Center and Research Institute authorized by 44 this subparagraph shall not be less than the amount that would 45 have been paid to the H. Lee Moffitt Cancer Center and Research 46 Institute for fiscal year 1998-1999 had payments been made for the entire fiscal year rather than for a 6-month period thereof. 47

Beginning July 1, 2002, and continuing through June 30, 48 2. 49 2004, the division shall, in addition to the distribution authorized in subparagraph 1., from month to month certify to the 50 51 Chief Financial Officer the amount derived from the cigarette tax 52 imposed by s. 210.02, less the service charges provided for in s. 53 215.20 and less 0.9 percent of the amount derived from the 54 cigarette tax imposed by s. 210.02, which shall be deposited into 55 the Alcoholic Beverage and Tobacco Trust Fund, specifying an amount equal to 0.2632 percent of the net collections, and that 56 57 amount shall be paid to the Board of Directors of the H. Lee 58 Moffitt Cancer Center and Research Institute, established under

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59 s. 1004.43, by warrant drawn by the Chief Financial Officer. 60 Beginning January 1, 2008 July 1, 2004, and continuing through June 30, 2038 2016, the division shall, in addition to the 61 distribution authorized in subparagraph 1., from month to month 62 63 certify to the Chief Financial Officer the amount derived from 64 the cigarette tax imposed by s. 210.02, less the service charges provided for in s. 215.20 and less 0.9 percent of the amount 65 66 derived from the cigarette tax imposed by s. 210.02, which shall 67 be deposited into the Alcoholic Beverage and Tobacco Trust Fund, 68 specifying an amount equal to 1.47 percent of the net 69 collections, and that amount shall be paid to the Board of 70 Directors of the H. Lee Moffitt Cancer Center and Research 71 Institute, established under s. 1004.43, by warrant drawn by the 72 Chief Financial Officer. These funds are appropriated monthly out 73 of the Cigarette Tax Collection Trust Fund, to be used for the 74 purpose of constructing, furnishing, and equipping a cancer 75 research, treatment, and related facilities facility at the 76 University of South Florida adjacent to the H. Lee Moffitt Cancer 77 Center and Research Institute. In fiscal years 2004-2005 and 78 thereafter, the appropriation to the H. Lee Moffitt Cancer Center 79 and Research Institute authorized by this subparagraph shall not 80 be less than the amount that would have been paid to the H. Lee 81 Moffitt Cancer Center and Research Institute in fiscal year 2001-82 2002, had this subparagraph been in effect.

3. The funds to be paid to the H. Lee Moffitt Cancer Center
and Research Institute under this paragraph may be pledged to pay
bonds and related financial products issued or incurred in
connection with the financing of cancer research, treatment, and
related facilities described in this paragraph. It is the intent

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88 of the Legislature that to the extent the cigarette tax is 89 amended or repealed or the provisions of this paragraph are 90 modified in a manner that would adversely affect bonds issued for such purpose, the Legislature shall provide alternative funding 91 sources in an amount sufficient to pay any deficit in the amount 92 93 required for such debt service. 94 Section 2. Section 210.201, Florida Statutes, is amended to 95 read: 96 210.201 Cancer facilities research facility at the 97 University of South Florida; establishment; funding. -- The Board of Directors of the H. Lee Moffitt Cancer Center and Research 98 99 Institute shall construct, furnish, and equip, and shall covenant to complete, the cancer research facility at the University of 100 South Florida adjacent to the H. Lee Moffitt Cancer Center and 101 102 Research Institute. Moneys transferred to the Board of Directors 103 of the H. Lee Moffitt Cancer Center and Research Institute 104 pursuant to s. 210.20 shall be used to secure financing to pay, 105 or secure bonds or financial products issued or incurred in 106 connection with the financing of, costs related to constructing, 107 furnishing, and equipping the cancer research, treatment, and 108 related facilities facility. Such financing may include the 109 issuance of tax-exempt bonds or other forms of indebtedness by a local authority, municipality, or county pursuant to parts II and 110 111 III of chapter 159. Such bonds shall not constitute state bonds 112 for purposes of s. 11, Art. VII of the State Constitution, but shall constitute bonds of a "local agency," as defined in s. 113 114 159.27(4). The cigarette tax dollars pledged to the facilities 115 this facility pursuant to s. 210.20 may be replaced annually by the Legislature from tobacco litigation settlement proceeds. 116

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117 Section 3. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law 118 and shall operate retroactively to January 1, 2008.
