Section 2. Subsection (1) of section 604.15, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

604.15 Dealers in agricultural products; definitions.--For the purpose of ss. 604.15-604.34, the following words and terms, when used, shall be construed to mean:

(1) "Agricultural products" means the natural products of the farm, nursery, grove, orchard, vineyard, garden, and apiary (raw or manufactured); sod; tropical foliage; horticulture; hay; livestock; milk and milk products; poultry and poultry products; the fruit of the saw palmetto (meaning the fruit of the Serenoa repens); limes (meaning the fruit Citrus aurantifolia, variety Persian, Tahiti, Bearss, or Florida Key limes); and any other

18 nonexempt agricultural products produced in the state, except
 19 tobacco, sugarcane, tropical foliage, timber and timber
 20 byproducts, forest products as defined in s. 591.17, and citrus
 21 other than limes.

22 Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2008.
