Section 2. Section 823.145, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

823.145 Disposal by open burning of materials ~~mulch plastic~~ used in agricultural operations.--Polyethylene agricultural mulch plastic; damaged, nonsalvageable, untreated wood pallets; and packing material that cannot feasibly be recycled, that are used in connection with agricultural operations related to the growing, harvesting, or maintenance of crops, may be disposed of by open burning provided that no public nuisance or any condition that adversely affects the environment or ~~affecting~~ the public health is created ~~thereby~~ and that state or federal national ambient air quality standards are not violated.
