The potential success of 17 desalination projects would benefit the communities they 18 19 directly serve and the state as a whole by preserving existing 20 natural water resources and providing a practical means of 21 ensuring adequate supplies of water for future generations of 22 Floridians. Therefore, it is the intent of the Legislature to aggressively pursue desalination technologies for use in the 23 24 state. DESALINATION TECHNOLOGY STUDY; REPORT. -- The Secretary 25 (2) 26 of Environmental Protection is directed to coordinate with the water management districts to conduct a study examining all 27 current and available desalination technologies. The study shall 28
