8 (15) Notwithstanding the provisions of this section, the
9 Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles may designate
10 the United States Transportation Security Administration's
11 Transportation Worker Identification Credential card as the
12 Uniform Port Access Credential Card. The department may set and
13 collect a fee for entering a Transportation Worker
14 Identification Credential cardholder into the Uniform Port
15 Access Credential System. This fee may not exceed the actual
