26 renewed ~~extended~~ upon application, payment of the fees required  
27 by s. 322.21, and successful passage of any required  
28 examination, unless the department has reason to believe that  
29 the licensee is no longer qualified to receive a license.

30 (b) Notwithstanding any other provision of this chapter,
