27 of every application for initial licensure, verify whether
28 certain facts set forth in the application are true. Each
29 applicant, general partner in the case of a partnership, or
30 corporate officer and director in the case of a corporate
31 applicant, must file a set of fingerprints with the department
32 for the purpose of determining any prior criminal record or any
33 outstanding warrants. The department shall submit the
34 fingerprints to the Department of Law Enforcement for state
35 processing and forwarding to the Federal Bureau of Investigation
36 for federal processing. The actual cost of ~~such~~ state and federal
37 processing shall be borne by the applicant and is ~~to be~~ in
38 addition to the fee for licensure. The department may issue a
39 license to an applicant pending the results of the fingerprint
40 investigation, which license is fully revocable if the department
41 subsequently determines that any facts set forth in the
42 application are not true or correctly represented.
