8 Section 6. 583.13 Labeling and advertising requirements
9 for dressed poultry; unlawful acts.--

10 (1) It is unlawful for any dealer or broker to sell, offer
11 for sale, or hold for the purpose of sale in the state any
12 dressed or ready-to-cook poultry in bulk unless such poultry is
13 packed in a container clearly bearing a label, not less than 3
14 inches by 5 inches, on which shall be plainly and legibly
15 printed, in letters not less than one-fourth inch 1/4 in height,
16 ~~the grade and the part name or whole-bird statement of such~~
17 ~~poultry. The grade may be expressed in the term "premium,"~~

18 ~~"good," or "standard," or as the grade of another state or~~
19 ~~federal agency the standards of quality of which, by law, are~~

22 (2) It is unlawful to sell unpackaged dressed or ready-to-
23 cook poultry at retail unless such poultry is labeled by a
24 placard immediately adjacent to the poultry or unless each bird
25 is individually labeled to show ~~the grade and~~ the part name or
26 whole-bird statement. The placard shall be no smaller than 7
27 inches by 7 inches in size, and the required labeling information
28 shall be legibly and plainly printed on the placard in letters
29 not smaller than 1 inch in height.

30 (3) It is unlawful to sell packaged dressed or ready-to-
31 cook poultry at retail unless such poultry is labeled to show ~~the~~
32 ~~grade,~~ the part name or whole-bird statement, the net weight of
33 the poultry, and the name and address of the dealer. The size of
34 the type on the label must be one-eighth inch or larger. A
35 placard immediately adjacent to such poultry may be used to
36 indicate ~~the grade and~~ the part name or whole-bird statement, but
37 not the net weight of the poultry or the name and address of the
38 dealer.

39 (4) It is unlawful to use dressed or ready-to-cook poultry
40 in bulk in the preparation of food served to the public, or to
41 hold such poultry for the purpose of such use, unless the poultry
42 when received was packed in a container clearly bearing a label,
43 not less than 3 inches by 5 inches, on which was plainly and
44 legibly printed, in letters not less than one-fourth inch in
45 height, ~~the grade and~~ the part name or whole-bird statement of
