20	(a) The department shall develop a Florida Tennis license
21	plate as provided in this section. The word "Florida" must appear

30 1. Up to 5 percent of the proceeds from the annual use fees 31 may be used by the Florida Sports Foundation to administer the 32 Florida Youth Tennis Programs. The United States Tennis Association Florida Section 33 2. 34 shall receive the first \$60,000 in proceeds from the annual use 35 fees for the programs of the United States Tennis Association 36 Florida Section headquarters in Daytona Beach. Thereafter, 15 37 percent of the proceeds from the annual use fees shall be 38 provided to the United States Tennis Association Florida Section. 39 3. The remaining proceeds from the annual use fees shall be 40 available for grants by the United States Tennis Association 41 Florida Section Foundation to nonprofit organizations to operate 42 youth tennis programs, for building and maintaining public tennis 43 courts, and for marketing the license plates. All grant 44 recipients shall provide to the United States Tennis Association 45 Florida Section Foundation an annual program and financial report 46 regarding the use of grant funds.
