2 Appropriations (Webster) recommended the following **amendment**:

4 **Senate Amendment (with title amendment)**

5 Between lines 95 and 96,  
6 insert:

7 Section 4. Section 318.195, Florida Statutes, is created to  
8 read:

9 318.195 Enhanced penalties for moving violations causing  
10 injury or death to motorcyclists.--

11 (1) A person who is convicted of a moving violation that  
12 causes serious bodily injury, as defined in s. 316.1933, to a  
13 person riding on a motorcycle commits a misdemeanor of the second  
14 degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082 or s. 775.083, and  
15 shall pay a fine of not less than \$500, serve a minimum of 30  
16 days of incarceration, and attend a driver improvement course.

17 The court shall also revoke the person's driver's license for not  
18 less than 30 days.

19 (2) A person who is convicted of a moving violation that  
20 causes or contributes to causing the death of a person riding on  
21 a motorcycle commits a misdemeanor of the first degree,  
22 punishable as provided in s. 775.082 or s. 775.083, and shall pay  
23 a fine of not less than \$1,000, serve a minimum of 90 days of  
24 incarceration, and, in lieu of the requirements of s. 322.0261,  
25 attend an advanced driver improvement course. The court shall  
26 also revoke the person's driver's license for not less than 1  
27 year.

28 (3) This section does not prohibit a person from being  
29 charged with, convicted of, or punished for any other violation  
30 of law.

36 creating s. 318.195, F.S.; providing that a person who  
37 is convicted of a moving violation that causes or  
38 contributes to causing serious injury to or the death  
39 of a person riding a motorcycle commits a misdemeanor  
40 offense; requiring that the offender pay a specified  
41 fine, serve a minimum of period of incarceration, and  
42 attend a driver improvement course; requiring the court  
43 to revoke the person's driver's license for a specified  
44 period; providing criminal penalties; providing that  
45 the act does not prohibit the offender from being
