18 (a) The department shall develop a Horse Country license
19 plate as provided in this subsection. However, the requirements
20 of s. 320.08053 must be met prior to the issuance of the plate.
21 Horse Country license plates must bear the colors and design
22 approved by the department. The word "Florida" must appear at the
23 top of the plate, and the words "Horse Country" must appear at
24 the bottom of the plate.

25 (b) The license plate annual use fees shall be distributed
26 to PCMI Properties, Inc., to fund its activities, programs, and
27 projects within the state. Funds must be used in this state. PCMI
28 Properties, Inc., may retain all revenue from the annual use fees
29 until up to \$60,000 of its documented startup costs for
30 developing and establishing the plate have been recovered.
31 Thereafter, revenue from the annual use fees shall be used as
32 follows:

33 1. Up to 25 percent of the annual use fee revenue may be
34 used for promotion and marketing of the plate.

35 2. Funds may be used as necessary for annual audit or
36 compliance affidavit costs.

37 3. The remaining revenue shall be used for programs
38 involved in the rehabilitation of at-risk youth as directed by
39 the Board of Trustees of PCMI Properties, Inc. Such funds may be
40 used to provide educational materials, athletic equipment,
41 transportation, food, medical services, counseling, scholarships,
42 and other direct administrative and program expenses. The funds
43 may also be used as grants for expanding youth rehabilitation
44 programs in the state. Special consideration shall be given to
45 programs using horses and other livestock in efforts to redirect
46 at-risk youth.

48 (a) Notwithstanding s. 320.08053, the department shall
49 develop an I Believe license plate as provided in this section. I
50 Believe license plates must bear the colors and design approved
51 by the department. The word "Florida" must appear at the top of
52 the plate, and the words "I Believe" must appear at the bottom of
53 the plate.

54 (b) The requirements of s. 320.08053 must be met prior to
55 the issuance of the plate. Thereafter, the license plate annual
56 use fees shall be distributed to Faith in Teaching, Inc., to fund
57 activities, programs, and projects that promote faith-based
58 education for youth within the state. Faith in Teaching, Inc.,
59 may retain all revenue from the annual use fees until all startup
60 costs for developing and establishing the plate have been
61 recovered. Thereafter, up to 10 percent of the annual use fee
62 revenue may be used for administrative, promotional, and
63 marketing costs.
