25	(3) If the sale is conducted by electronic means as

27	service charge of \$40 for services in conducting or contracting
28	for the electronic sale, which service charge shall be assessed
29	as costs and shall be advanced by the plaintiff before the sale.
30	If the clerk requires advance electronic deposits to secure the
31	right to bid, such deposits are not subject to the fee under s.
32	28.24(10). The portion of an advance deposit from a winning
