

## CHAMBER ACTION

Senate House Comm: RS 4/3/2008

The Committee on Community Affairs (Geller) recommended the following amendment:

## Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

Delete everything after the enacting clause and insert:

Section 1. Subsection (8) is added to section 212.055, Florida Statutes, to read:

212.055 Discretionary sales surtaxes; legislative intent; authorization and use of proceeds. -- It is the legislative intent that any authorization for imposition of a discretionary sales surtax shall be published in the Florida Statutes as a subsection of this section, irrespective of the duration of the levy. Each enactment shall specify the types of counties authorized to levy; the rate or rates which may be imposed; the maximum length of time the surtax may be imposed, if any; the procedure which must be followed to secure voter approval, if required; the purpose

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for which the proceeds may be expended; and such other requirements as the Legislature may provide. Taxable transactions and administrative procedures shall be as provided in s. 212.054.

- (8) EMERGENCY FIRE RESCUE SERVICES AND FACILITIES SURTAX. --
- (a) Upon meeting the condition specified in paragraph (c), the governing authority of a county providing emergency fire rescue services may authorize, by ordinance, the levy of a discretionary sales surtax of 1 percent as provided in this subsection for emergency fire rescue services and facilities.
- (b) The ordinance shall be effective if approved by a majority of the electors of the county voting in the referendum. The ballot title and summary shall briefly describe the purposes and uses of the surtax and conform to the requirements of s. 101.161.
- (c) As a condition precedent to holding the referendum authorized by this subsection, the county shall enter into an interlocal agreement with the governing body of the municipality or municipalities representing a majority of the population of the incorporated area of the county. Such interlocal agreement shall include provisions for improving coordination and efficiencies in service delivery and specify the duration of the surtax.
- 1. The interlocal agreement shall specify a distribution formula for dividing the entire proceeds of the surtax among county government and all municipalities and independent special fire districts within the county. Alternatively, the interlocal agreement may provide for the proceeds to be distributed in accordance with subparagraph 2.
- 2. If the interlocal agreement does not specify a distribution formula, the proceeds of the surtax shall be

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distributed among the county government and all municipalities and independent special fire districts within the county based on the fire rescue services and facilities expenditures of each for the immediately preceding 5 fiscal years, as a proportion of the total of such expenditures for each entity.

(d) Upon the surtax taking effect and the initiation of collections, the county shall reduce the ad valorem tax levy in its next and subsequent budgets by the estimated amount of revenue to the county provided by the surtax. A municipality or independent special fire district shall reduce the ad valorem tax levy in its next and subsequent budgets by the estimated amount of revenue provided to that municipality or special district by the surtax.
