A bill to be entitled An act relating to ballot initiatives; creating s. 106.151, F.S.; prohibiting a state agency or political subdivision from making contributions to or being a member of an organization that supports or opposes candidates or issues; providing penalties; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 106.151, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

- 106.151 Prohibited acts by public entities.--
- (1) A state agency, political subdivision, or instrumentality thereof may not make a contribution to or be a member of any organization, including a trade, industry, or professional association, political committee, or committee of continuous existence, which supports or opposes candidates or issues.
- (2) Any officer or person acting on behalf of a trade, industry, or professional association, political committee, or committee of continuous existence that supports or opposes candidates or issues and accepts a contribution from or includes in its membership a state agency, political subdivision, or instrumentality thereof commits a misdemeanor of the first degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082 or s. 775.083.
 - Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2008.
