Between line(s) 59 and 60, insert:

Section 6. Subsection (3) of section 1011.71, Florida Statutes, as amended by section 4 of chapter 2007-328, Laws of Florida, is amended to read:

1011.71 District school tax.--

(3) A school district that has met the reduction requirements regarding class size for the 2007-2008 fiscal year pursuant to s. 1003.03 for K-12 students for whom the school district provides the educational facilities and certifies to the Commissioner of Education that the district does not need

16 all of its discretionary 2-mill capital improvement revenue for
17 capital outlay purposes and all of the district's instructional
18 space needs for the next 5 years can be met from capital outlay
19 sources that the district reasonably expects to receive during
20 the next 5 years from local revenues and from currently
21 appropriated state facilities funding or from alternative
22 scheduling or construction, leasing, rezoning, or technological
23 methodologies that exhibit sound management may expend, subject
24 to the provisions of s. 200.065, up to \$65 ~~\$25~~ per unweighted
