7 Section 2. Section 376.30715, Florida Statutes, is amended to  
8 read:

9 376.30715 Innocent victim petroleum storage system  
10 restoration.--A contaminated site acquired by the current owner  
11 prior to July 1, 1990, which has ceased operating as a petroleum  
12 storage or retail business prior to January 1, 1985, is eligible  
13 for financial assistance pursuant to s. 376.305(6),  
14 notwithstanding s. 376.305(6)(a). For purposes of this section,  
15 the term "acquired" means the acquisition of title to the  
16 property; however, a subsequent transfer of the property to a  
17 spouse, a surviving spouse in trust or free of trust, or a

18 revocable trust created for the benefit of the settlor does not  
19 disqualify the site from financial assistance pursuant to s.  
20 376.305(6). Eligible sites shall be ranked in accordance with s.  
21 376.3071(5).
