The Legislature finds that it is a public 34 35 necessity to make confidential and exempt from disclosure 36 information held in the organ and tissue donor registry which 37 would identify a donor. Such personal identifying information, if publicly available, could be used to invade the personal 38 privacy of the donor identified in the registry. The decision to 39 make or revoke an anatomical gift is a private matter of 40 personal choice.
