Section 2. Paragraph (d) of subsection (5) of section 288.1162, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

288.1162 Professional sports franchises; spring training franchises; duties. --

(5)

Funds may not be expended to subsidize privately owned and maintained facilities for use by the spring training franchise. Funds may be used to relocate a retained spring training franchise to another unit of local government upon approval of the Office of Tourism, Trade, and Economic Development. The office shall establish criteria for use of the



funds to relocate a retained spring training franchise consistent with the requirements of this section only if the existing unit of local government with the retained spring training franchise agrees to the relocation. A spring training franchise that is eligible for a sales tax refund pursuant to s. 212.20 and that relocates from one community in this state to another community may not receive more than 90 percent of the refund. The office may adopt rules pursuant to ss. 120.536(1) and 120.54 to administer this section.

Section 3. On or before December 31, 2008, the Office of Tourism, Trade, and Economic Development shall develop a comprehensive strategic plan, including the use of financial resources, for the purpose of retaining the tradition of spring training in Florida. Such plan shall identify the financial impact spring training has on this state and identify efforts made by other states to organize spring training efforts and the effects of those efforts on Florida's relationship with professional baseball.
