Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

providing an effective date.

Section 1. Section 1012.221, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

- 1012.221 Minimum salaries for public school teachers.--
- (1) By the beginning of the 2010-2011 school year:
- (a) The beginning salary for full-time public school teachers shall be no less than the national average beginning salary for full-time public school teachers as determined by the United States Department of Education.
- (b) The average salary for full-time public school teachers shall be no less than the national average salary for full-time public school teachers as determined by the United States

 Department of Education.
- (2) Increases in the beginning and the average full-time public school teacher salaries shall be independent of employee benefits and shall not alter, jeopardize, or decrease existing employee benefits. Payment of the costs associated with increasing beginning and average teacher salaries is the responsibility of the state and not of school districts. Nothing in this section shall impair collective bargaining.
