Section 1. This act may be cited as the "Sergeant Chris Reyka Memorial Crime Prevention Act."

Section 2. Pilot Project relating to surveillance systems for late-night businesses. --

- (1) PURPOSE. -- This law creates a pilot project in Broward and Palm Beach counties to establish a grant program to provide funding for the purchase and installation of parking lot surveillance systems for late-night businesses. The use of these systems may serve to prevent crime and will assist law enforcement agencies in the event that crimes occur.
 - (2) DEFINITIONS. -- For purposes of this section, the term:

- (a) "Late-night business" means a business in Broward or Palm Beach county that is open to the general public between the hours of 11 p.m. and 5 a.m. on a regular basis.
 - (b) "Regular basis:" means a minimum of 200 days per year.
- (c) "Surveillance system" means a digital video security camera system that meets the specifications established by the applicable county sheriff's office.
- (3) GRANT QUALIFICATIONS. -- If a felony has occurred at a late-night business after January 1, 2008, that business may apply to the county sheriff's office to receive reimbursement of up to \$1,000 for expenditures related to the purchase and installation of a surveillance system. The application must include receipts relating to the costs of the purchase and installation of the equipment. The sheriff's office may establish additional qualifications criteria.
- (4) PILOT PROJECT FUNDING. -- Subject to appropriation, grants provided by the counties sheriff offices to qualified businesses shall be funded through grants provided by the Florida Department of Law Enforcement with funds from the Byrne Memorial Local Law Enforcement Assistance Program funds.
