Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsection (8) of section 377.707, Florida Statutes, as created by HB ____, 2008 Regular Session, is renumbered as subsection (9), and a new subsection (8) is added to that section to read:

- (a) Materials that relate to methods of manufacture or production, potential trade secrets, potentially patentable material, actual trade secrets, business transactions, financial and proprietary information, and agreements or proposals to receive funding that are received, generated, ascertained, or

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discovered by the Florida Advanced Combustion Center, Inc., including its affiliates or subsidiaries and partnership participants, such as private enterprises, educational institutions, and other organizations, are confidential and exempt from the provisions of s. 119.07(1) and s. 24(a), Art. I of the State Constitution.

(b) This subsection is subject to the Open Government
Sunset Review Act in accordance with s. 119.15 and shall stand
repealed on October 2, 2013, unless reviewed and saved from
repeal through reenactment by the Legislature.

Section 2. The Legislature finds that it is a public necessity that materials that relate to methods of manufacture or production, potential trade secrets, potentially patentable material, actual trade secrets, business transactions, financial and proprietary information, and agreements or proposals to receive funding that are received, generated, ascertained, or discovered by the Florida Advanced Combustion Center, Inc., including its affiliates or subsidiaries and partnership participants, such as private enterprises, educational institutions, and other organizations, be held confidential and exempt from public records requirements. Technology commercialization and manufacturing programs must utilize materials that relate to methods of manufacture or production, potential trade secrets, potentially patentable material, actual trade secrets, business transactions, financial and proprietary information, and agreements or proposals to be effective. If competitors were privy to such information, they could take advantage of that information to the financial detriment of the corporation submitting the information or proposal, which would

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chill participation in programs of the Florida Advanced

Combustion Energy Center, Inc., and impede the effectiveness of the corporation.

Section 3. This act shall take effect on the same date that Senate Bill ____ or similar legislation takes effect, if such legislation is adopted in the same legislative session or an extension thereof and becomes law.
