CS/HB 289 2008

A bill to be entitled

An act relating to state parks; amending s. 258.014, F.S.; providing free admission to state parks on certain state and federal holidays for qualified persons to honor those serving or having served in the United States Armed Forces; encouraging the Division of Recreation and Parks to hold special events and take other actions to show appreciation for those who have served in the Armed Forces; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsection (3) is added to section 258.014, Florida Statutes, to read:

258.014 Fees for use of state parks.--

(3) The Division of Recreation and Parks shall waive admission fees for all active duty military personnel, and the spouse and minor child of such person, with valid identification, on the Memorial Day holiday and for all visitors on the Veterans' Day holiday in honor of those who have served in the United States Armed Forces. The division is also encouraged to hold special events and take other actions appropriate to show the appreciation for those who have served our country in the Armed Forces.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2008.
