WHEREAS, several proposals have been put forth by members of Congress to raise the federal excise tax on gasoline, and

WHEREAS, historically high gasoline prices have greatly increased the costs of driving and increasing federal gasoline taxes will hurt residential and business consumers even more, and

WHEREAS, among residential consumers, lower-income consumers whose fuel costs consume a proportionally larger share of their budgets and consumers who reside in rural or suburban areas and must drive long distances for their livelihoods will be hurt the most, and

WHEREAS, among business consumers, the nation's airlines, merchant marine industry, and trucking industry will be disadvantaged since fuel costs are a proportionately larger share of these industry's costs, and

WHEREAS, increasing the federal excise taxes on gasoline increases the cost burden in the transportation sector, increasing costs associated with virtually all products requiring transportation to market, and

WHEREAS, increased federal gasoline taxes would lead to reductions in the disposable income of consumers who must pay more for their own fuel and transported products, and

WHEREAS, reductions in consumers' disposable income adversely affect economic growth in general and this state's tourist-based economy in particular, NOW, THEREFORE,
