WHEREAS, his career in the Army developed from his service in the Rangers in Vietnam through several reconnaissance units and Ranger Battalions to Special Forces A Teams, and

WHEREAS, Sergeant Major Moore was one of the first members of the HALO (High Altitude - Low Opening) jump team and he logged thousands of jumps while in military service, and

WHEREAS, he received more than 21 awards and decorations during his outstanding career, including the Silver Star, the Legion of Merit, the Bronze Star, and the Air Medal, and

WHEREAS, following his stalwart military service to his country, Sergeant Major Moore retired with his wife, Leone, to Santa Rosa Beach, Florida, where he continues an active life with other retired Rangers and their families, and

WHEREAS, the Army Ranger Hall of Fame was formed to honor and preserve the contributions of the most extraordinary U.S. Rangers in American history, and its Selection Board takes particular care to ensure that only the most extraordinary Rangers are inducted, and

WHEREAS, Sergeant Major Frank O. Moore will be inducted into the Army Ranger Hall of Fame at Fort Benning, Georgia, on June 11, 2008, NOW, THEREFORE,
