Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

circumstances; providing an effective date.

Section 1. Section 624.4055, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

624.4055 Restrictions on existing private passenger automobile insurance.—Effective January 1, 2008, No insurer writing private passenger automobile insurance in this state may continue to write such insurance if the insurer writes homeowners' insurance in another state but not in this state, unless the insurer writing private passenger automobile insurance in this state is affiliated with an insurer writing homeowners' insurance in this state or also writes homeowners' insurance policies in this state and at least 50 percent of the insurer's policies are homeowners' insurance policies.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2008.
