20	of 20 percent of total diesel fuel purchases for use in state-
21	owned diesel vehicles and equipment shall be biodiesel fuel
22	(B20), subject to availability.
23	(2) By July 1, 2009, a minimum of 5 percent, by January 1,
24	2010, a minimum of 10 percent, and by January 1, 2011, a minimum
25	of 20 percent of total fuel purchases for use by state-owned
26	flex-fuel vehicles shall be ethanol, subject to availability.

The report must contain the number of gallons purchased since July 1, 2008, the average price of biodiesel and ethanol, 33 and a description of fleet performance. 34 35 Section 2. School district biodiesel usage .--(1) By January 1, 2009, a minimum of 20 percent of total 36 37 diesel fuel purchases for use by school districts shall be 38 biodiesel fuel (B20), subject to availability. 39 (2) If a school district contracts with another government entity or private entity to provide transportation services for 40 41 any of its pupils, the biodiesel fuel requirement established 42 under subsection (1) shall be part of that contract. However, 43 this requirement applies only to contracts entered into on or 44 after July 1, 2008.
