Has submitted evidence of the active licensed practice of pharmacy, including practice in community or public 23 health by persons employed by a governmental entity, in another 24 25 jurisdiction for at least 2 of the immediately preceding 5 years 26 or evidence of successful completion of board-approved 27 postgraduate training or a board-approved clinical competency 28 examination within the year immediately preceding application 29 for licensure; or
